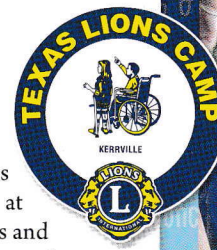


Texas Lions Camp

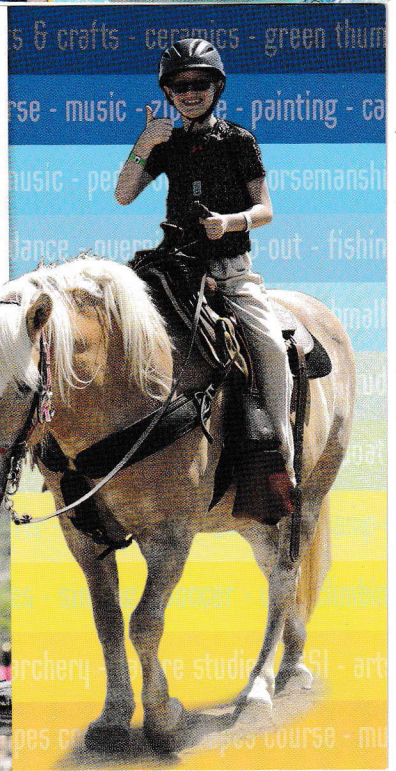
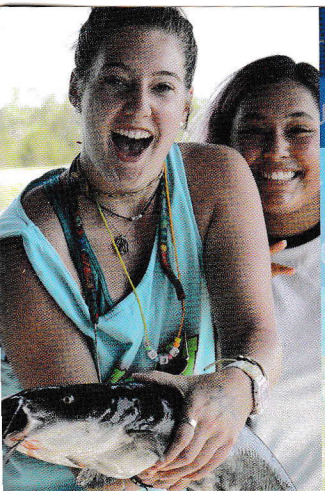
is a summer camping facility dedicated to serving children from the State of Texas who have physical disabilities and Type-1 diabetes. The camp is located on over 500 acres of hills and woodlands in the beautiful Texas Hill Country. Programs at Texas Lions Camp offer campers a chance to try new activities and create long-lasting friends while developing greater self-esteem and independence. Children eligible to participate in the summer camp program must be between the ages of seven and sixteen and have a qualifying physical disability. Children with Type-1 diabetes must be between the ages of eight and fifteen, and Down syndrome twelve to sixteen years old.

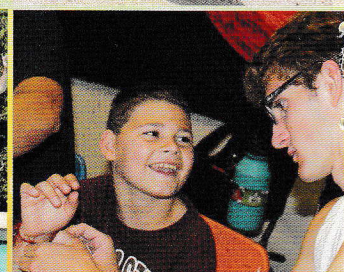
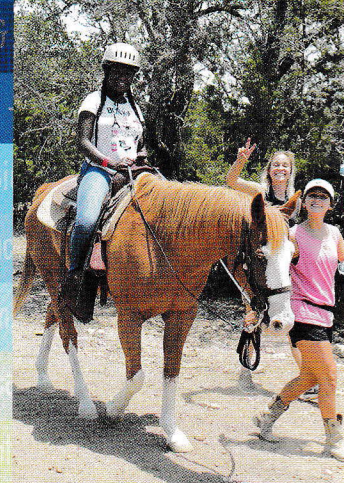
Diabetes Sessions

As impressive as our facilities are, our staff are even better. They can assist in building the dream and help your organization make that dream a reality.

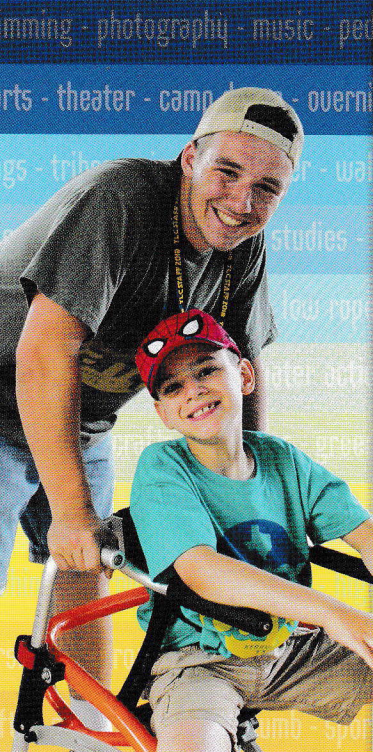

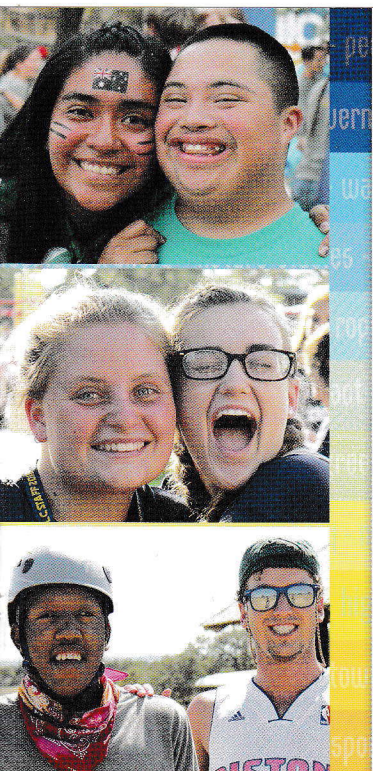
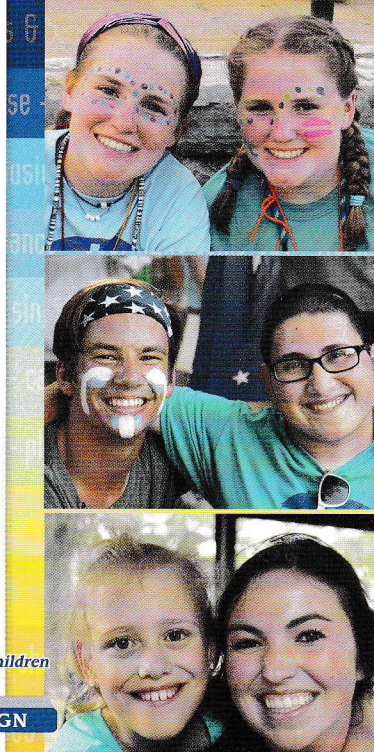
Today's Promise...

In response to the terrible polio epidemic that swept the country and forever changed the lives of so many children, the Lions of Texas, conceived and chartered the Texas Lions Camp in 1949. Their commitment to seeing that no child faces life's challenges alone provided the inspiration to structure a camp that would build the self-esteem of campers and renew families through summer camping programs. After four years of building and planning, the camp opened its doors in 1953 and was formally dedicated "to the perpetual use and enjoyment of physically disabled children in Texas." Since that time, the Texas Lions Camp has dynamically evolved to include children who have all manner and types of physical disabilities, diabetes and cancer.

Today, we celebrate a rich history of having served over 73,000 children. And, we are planning for kids yet to come.

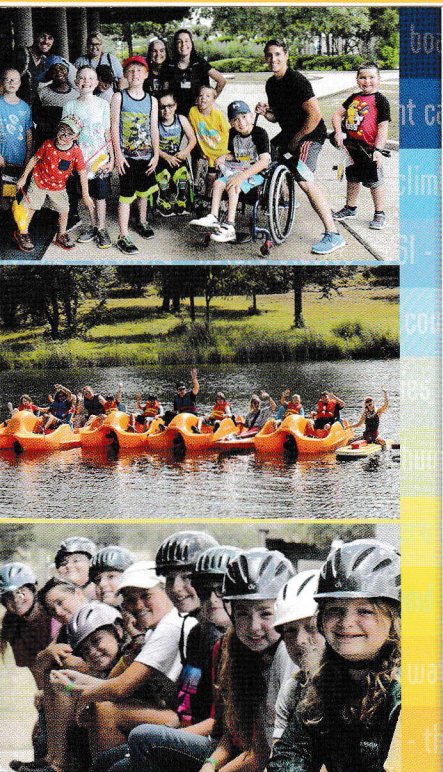
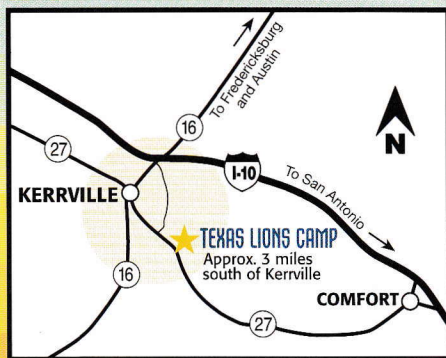


TRAVELING I-10 E:
